

HERE ARE SOME EXAMPLES OF HOW YOUR DONATIONS IMPACT YOUR COMMUNITY:

\$1 per Week

Provides a full day of shelter for one person including breakfast, lunch, dinner, a cot, two blankets and a comfort kit.

Supports financial assistance for 2 children for one week of after school care.

\$2 per Week

Provides emergency services to five sexual assault victims.

Provides three families of four with 10 meals per person. (120 total meals)

\$5 per Week

Provides bus passes for one week for up to 20 shelter residents to go on job interviews.

Sponsors three weeks for a child in the after school tutorial program.

\$10 per Week

Provides diapers, wipes and formula for 10 infants whose family has been impacted by a disaster/ emergency occurrence.

Helps one patient receive one full year of life-saving medications.

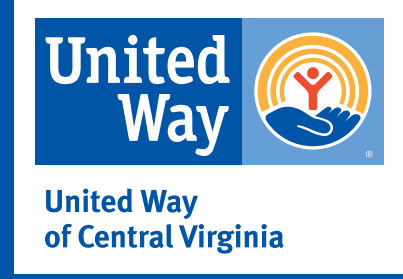

HEALTH

United Way advances health and wellness by improving healthcare accessibility for individuals of all ages in Central Virginia.

33,894 are living without health insurance.

1 in 7 babies born to African-American women are low birth weight (2x higher than whites).

94% of enrolled children had a primary health care provider within two months after enrollment.

87% of individuals served remained independent in their homes.

EDUCATION

United Way ensures every child gets a strong start in life and has the opportunity to become a contributing member of society.

3 months in math and reading skills lost in the summer by economically disadvantaged students.

32% of children do not pass third grade reading scores.

88% of youth remained matched with a mentor for six months.

81% of children in an afterschool program maintained a "C" or better in CORE subjects: math, science, English, social studies, writing and reading.

FINANCIAL STABILITY

United Way helps stabilize families through programs that reduce poverty, improve job opportunities, and develop life skills.

13,496 of all renting households in Central Virginia spend over one-third of their income in rent.

38% of households lack savings to make ends meet if income is interrupted.

100% of partner families improved their financial position through reallocation of personal expenses.

1,346 individuals received financial assistance to prevent loss of utility service and **94%** of clients avoided eviction or foreclosure.

BASIC HUMAN NEEDS

United Way ensures every member of our community has the essentials that every human needs like water, shelter, food, and safety.

43,669 of our neighbors cannot afford the basic costs of living.

23,280 are lacking adequate access to food.

99,500 meals were provided to qualifying families.

18,672 total nights individuals were safely housed at local emergency shelters.
